We're looking for an enthusiastic and innovative leader with superior information management, organization, written and oral communication skills to provide psycho-educational assessments and related student support programming in all six district schools on a fee-for-service basis. We have a great

SD 10 is a respected innovator in place-conscious learning, environmental education, personalized learning, project-based learning and student inquiry. Under the direction of the Superintendent of Schools, the School Psychologist (SP) shall assist schools with the provision of psycho-educational assessment services and related programming to students. The SP supports students identified by school-based learning support teams as requiring psycho-educational assessment services.

The SP would be responsible for providing the following services:

- Psycho-educational assessment services for school-aged children including relevant programming and follow-up and support to the school personnel involved in carrying out instructional recommendations
- Written reports to the school and parents outlining assessment findings, recommendations, and the psychoeducational services, program or exercises to be provided
- \* Expertise at school-based team or Individual Education Plan (IEP) meetings as requested for those students who need this level of support. Not all students would require this level of support
- Professional learning workshops on a fee-for-service basis as requested when in the district
